Use	Example Sentences
Times of the day <i>*EXCEPTION: At night</i>	I have breakfast in <b>the</b> morning I go to the gym in <b>the</b> afternoon
Prepositions (in, on, at, to, from) + Compass direction	The sun rises in <b>the</b> east and sets in <b>the</b> west She lives on <b>the</b> north coast
Specific time periods	I'd love to have experienced life in <b>the</b> 1920's It's difficult to live in <b>the</b> 21 <sup>st</sup> Century
Before same	I have <b>the</b> same watch as you Did we go to <b>the</b> same school?
Body parts with direct objects	She hit me in <b>the</b> face She punched the child on <b>the</b> arm
