The difference in pronunciation of “the team” and “the army” is: The word team begins with a T, a consonant. When a word following “the” begins with a consonant, it’s pronounced as /ðə/ but when a word following “the” begins with a vowel, like “the army”, then it’s pronounced as /ði:/.
