A little	ə lɪtl	There is a little chocolate left
A lot of	ə lɒt ɒv	There are a lot of people
A number of	ə nʌmbər ɒv	There are a number of strawberries
A	æ	There isn't a banana
An	æn	There isn't an apple
Any	eni	There aren't any tomatoes
Lots of	lɒts ɒv	There are lots of dogs
