There are **3** different ways to pronounce the letters ED when they are at the end of a word. These are **/t/**, **/d/** and **/id/**.

If the penultimate sound in a verb, before the ED, is a voiced sound, then the pronunciation of the letters ED is /d/. These voiced sounds are: /b/, /d/, /n/, /m/, /j/, /ŋ/, /r/, /v/, /w/, /l/, /ð/, /ʒ/ and /z/.

Fill in the gaps with the correct letter/s.

If the penultimate sound is an exception sound, then the pronunciation of the letters ED is /id/. These exception sounds are: /t/ and /d/.
