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Video: Pronouncing S with Plurals

What are the two typical situations when a word ends in the letter S?

The typical situations when a word ends in the letter S are:

- 1) Regular plural forms
- 2) Third person singular of the present simple tense

What are the three different ways we can pronounce the letter S when it's the final letter in a word?

## Select the correct options to complete the sentences below.

The sound /k/ is a voiced / an unvoiced sound.

The sound /n/ is <u>a voiced</u> / an unvoiced sound.



Video: /S/ Pronunciation

If the penultimate letter in a verb is an unvoiced sound, then the pronunciation of the letter S is /s/. These unvoiced sounds are: /p/, /t/, /k/, /f/, /h/ and / $\theta$ /.



Video: /Z/ Pronunciation

If the penultimate letter in a verb is a voiced sound, then the pronunciation of the letter S is /z/. These voiced sounds are: /b/, /d/, /n/, /m/, /j/, /n/, /v/, /w/, /l/and /ð/.



Video: /IZ/ Pronunciation

If the penultimate letter is an exception sound, then the pronunciation of the letter S is /iz/. These special sounds are:  $\frac{1}{3}$ ,  $\frac{1}{3}$ ,  $\frac{1}{3}$ , and  $\frac{1}{3}$ .

If the penultimate letter is a vowel, then the pronunciation of the letter S is z/.
