




Vocabulary	Transcription	Definition	Example Sentence	Image
airport	<u>ei</u> əpɔ:t	A building where aeroplanes collect people and get ready to travel in the sky	When I go on holiday to France, I take an aeroplane from the airport.	
bank	bæŋk	A building where money is deposited and withdrawn	I always go to the bank to take out some money.	
bus station	<u>bʌs</u> steɪʃən	A place where buses park and where the drivers start their journey	I go to the bus station to get on the bus to go to work.	
café	<u>kæ</u> feɪ	A place where you can have a coffee or tea, or a few snacks	I go to the café to have a coffee with my friends.	







cinema	sɪnəmə	A place to watch films on a big screen	This afternoon, we will go to the cinema to watch a new film.	
factory	fæk <u>t</u> əri	A building with machines to manufacture products	I work in a factory that makes car parts.

hairdresser's	<u>heə</u> drɛsəs	A place where a professional hairdresser cuts and styles your hair	I have an appointment at the hairdresser's next weekend.	
hospital	<u>hɒspɪ</u> tl	A building where doctors and nurses provide medical treatment	He doesn't feel very well, so we will take him to the hospital.

market	maɪ <u>k</u> ɪt	A collection of individual vendors selling fresh food on the street or in an outdoor area	I go to the market every Sunday morning to buy fresh fruits and vegetables.	
museum	mjuː <u>z</u> ɪəm	A place with historical artefacts and information	We have a new museum in our city and it has artefacts from the 12th century.	
park	pɑːk	A large garden or outdoor area	We go for walks around the park when it is sunny.

pharmacy	<u>fɑː</u> məsi	A shop where medical supplies are sold	When I feel sick, I buy some tablets from the pharmacy.	
police station	<u>pə</u> liːs <u>steɪ</u> ʃən	A place where the police work	My husband is a police officer, so he works at the police station.

shop	ʃɒp	A place where something is sold E.g. toy shop, pet shop, clothes shop	We have lots of shops on our high street.	
shopping centre	<u>ʃɒp</u> ɪŋ <u>sɛn</u> tə	A large building filled with lots of shops	I go shopping in our local shopping centre.	
sports centre	sports <u>sɛn</u> tə	A place where you can do numerous sports activities (tennis, swimming etc...)	There are lots of activities in our sports centre.

sports stadium	spɔːts <u>steɪ</u> diəm	A large outdoor venue to hold large sports events or concerts	Our football teams play at the sports stadium.	
supermarket	<u>suː</u> pəməːkɪt	A shop that sells a large selection of food and drink	I visit the supermarket three times a week to buy my food and drink.	
theatre	<u>θ</u> ɪətə	A place for performances - singing, acting, dancing	I work at the local theatre because I am an actor.	
tourist information centre	<u>tʊə</u> rɪst ɪnfə <u>meɪ</u> ʃən <u>sɛn</u> tə	A place to collect information about a local area, such as local museums or attractions	When I visit a new city, I go to the tourist information centre to learn more about the city.	
town hall	taʊn hɔːl	A place for the local government to carry out administrative tasks	There are lots of events held at the town hall.
