



















book	bʊk	<i>I read lots of books.</i>	
calculator	<u>kæ</u> lkjʊleɪtə	<i>I do maths with a calculator.</i>	
chair	tʃeə	<i>I sit on my chair when I am tired.</i>	
clock	klɒk	<i>I can tell the time using my clock.</i>	
computer	kəm <u>pjuː</u> tə	<i>I type lots of things on my computer</i>

desk	dɛsk	I work at my desk. My desk is very big.	
door	dɔː	I close the door in my classroom when I teach.	
folder	<u>fəʊ</u> ldə	I keep all my important documents in a folder.	
highlighter	<u>haɪ</u> laɪtə	I use a highlighter for useful information in a text.	
laptop	<u>læp</u> tɒp	I take my laptop to all my meetings.	
magnet	<u>mæɡ</u> nɪt	I use magnets to stick information on my wall.

rubber	<u>rʌb</u> ə	If I make a mistake with my pencil, I can use a rubber to erase it. <b>American English: eraser</b>	
ruler	<u>ruːl</u> ə	When I want to draw a straight line, I use a ruler.

scissors	<u>s</u> ɪzəz	I cut things with scissors.	
whiteboard	<u>w</u> aɪt <b>ɪ</b> bɔːd	I teach my classes using my whiteboard. I write important information on my whiteboard.	
whiteboard pen	<u>w</u> aɪt <b>ɪ</b> bɔːd pɛn	I write important information on my whiteboard with a whiteboard pen. <b>American English: whiteboard marker</b>	
whiteboard rubber	<u>w</u> aɪt <b>ɪ</b> bɔːd rʌbər	If there is no space on my whiteboard, I use a whiteboard rubber to erase all the information. <b>American English: whiteboard eraser/ whiteboard cleaner</b>	
window	<u>w</u> ɪndəʊ	I look out the window to see the pretty houses.
