Sports Verbs

Verb	Phonetics	Explanation	Image
Bounce	bəʊns	This is the action when a ball touches the floor and goes back to the air again.	
Catch	kætʃ	This is the action when you receive a ball in your hands.	
Hit	hɪt	This is the action to push something with a lot of force.	
Hop	hɒp	This is the action when you take both feet off the ground so you are in the air and land on one foot only.	
Jump	dʒʌmp	This is the action when you take both feet off the ground so you are in the air.	
Kick	kɪk	This is the action when you move something with your feet.	
Run	rʌn	This is the action when you move something with your feet.
