airport	<u>eə</u> pɔːt	A building where aeroplanes collect people and get ready to travel in the sky	When I go on holiday to France, I take an aeroplane from the airport.	
bank	bæŋk	A building where money is deposited and withdrawn	I always go to the bank to take out some money.	
bus station	<u>bʌs</u> steɪʃən	A place where buses park and where the drivers start their journey	I go to the bus station to get on the bus to go to work.	
café	<u>kæ</u> feɪ	A place where you can have a coffee or tea, or a few snacks	I go to the café to have a coffee with my friends.	






Chemist's (Am: pharmacy)	<b>kɛm</b> ɪsts <b>fɑː</b> məsi	A shop where medical supplies are sold	<i>When I feel sick, I buy some tablets from the chemist's.</i>	
church	tʃɜːtʃ	A religious building in the Christian religion	<i>I'm very religious and I like to go to church every weekend.</i>

factory	<u>f</u> æktəri	A building with machines to manufacture products	I work in a factory that makes car parts.	
farm	farm	An area of land outside to grow animals or plants	My dad lives on a farm.

gym	dʒɪm	A private place to do personal exercise	I go to the gym every single day to do exercise.






library	<b>l</b> aɪbrəri	A building that contains books that you can borrow to read	I always borrow my books from the library.	
market	<b>m</b> ɑːkɪt	A collection of individual vendors selling fresh food on the street or in an outdoor area	I go to the market every Sunday morning to buy fresh fruits and vegetables.

pastry shop	<u>pe</u> ɪstri ʃɒp	A shop that sells cakes and pastries	The local pastry shop makes delicious birthday cakes.	
petrol station	<u>p</u> etrəl <u>steɪ</u> ʃən	A place where you can fill your car with petrol	We always need to go to the petrol station to put more petrol in our car.

restaurant	<b>rɛ</b> strɒnt	A place to eat food that somebody else cooks for you	My favourite restaurant is on the corner and it sells Mexican food.

shop (Am: store)	ʃɒp	A place where something is sold E.g. toy shop, pet shop, clothes shop	<i>We have lots of shops on our high street.</i>	
shopping centre	<u>ʃɒp</u> ɪŋ <u>sɛn</u> tə	A large building filled with lots of shops	<i>I go shopping in our local shopping centre.</i>	
sports centre	sports <u>sɛn</u> tə	A place where you can do numerous sports activities (tennis, swimming etc...)	<i>There are lots of activities in our sports centre.</i>	
sports stadium	sports <u>steɪ</u> diəm	A large outdoor venue to hold large sports events or concerts	<i>Our football teams play at the sports stadium.</i>

supermarket	<u>su</u> ˌpəməːkɪt	A shop that sells a large selection of food and drink	I visit the supermarket three times a week to buy my food and drink.	
theatre	<u>θ</u> ɪətrə	A place for performances - singing, acting, dancing	I work at the local theatre because I am an actor.	
tourist information centre	<u>tʊər</u> ɪst ɪnfə <u>meɪ</u> ʃən <u>sɛn</u> tə	A place to collect information about a local area, such as local museums or attractions	When I visit a new city, I go to the tourist information centre to learn more about the city.	
town hall	taʊn hɔːl	A place for the local government to carry out administrative tasks	There are lots of events held at the town hall.
