

Transcript Phrases

Phrase	Meaning
Yeah!	This is an informal way to say “yes”. Most native speakers say “yeah” instead of “yes”.
Tasty	This is an adjective that means “delicious”. For example, this cake is tasty! It is a positive adjective to describe a good flavour.
Do + infinitive	This structure is used to add emphasis to the positive meaning of the sentence. “I do like pizza” has the same meaning as “I like pizza”, but it is stronger and adds more emphasis to the sentence.
I’m a creature of habit	This means “I always do the same thing”. In the transcript, Hannah says “I’m a creature of habit for breakfast”, this means she eats the same thing for breakfast every day.
The list goes on	This means “etc...” There are numerous more examples, but I am not going to say them all.
To tend to do something	This means there is a high probability that you will do something. For example “I tend to go to the supermarket in the morning”- When I go to the supermarket, there is a high probability this will be in the morning.
At all	This adds to the negative feeling of a sentence, it makes the sentence more dramatic. This expression always goes at the end of a sentence.
An absolute must	This is something that is necessary and the majority of people do this. For example, “learning grammar is an absolute must if you want to improve your English”.
