

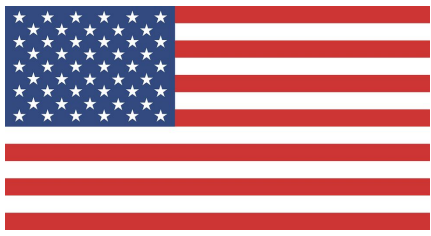


Transport English Variations

English is a popular language spoken in lots of countries. The main native countries are the United States and the United Kingdom.

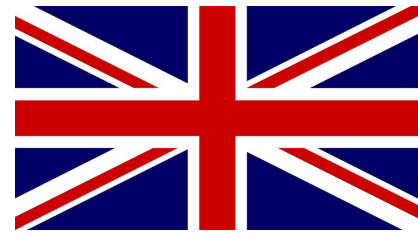
The English used in the US and the UK is sometimes different. We change the spelling, pronunciation and vocabulary. These are called different **variations** of the language.
