


Adverbs of Frequency

Adverbs of frequency tell us the number of times you complete something.



Adverbs of frequency are placed in very specific positions in a sentence.

Rule	Structure	Example
Affirmative	subject + FA + verb	l always dance
Affirmative (long adverb)	FA + subject + verb subject + verb + FA	Three time a week, I dance I dance three times a week
Affirmative (to be)	subject + be + FA + extra	l am always dancing
Negative	subject + neg + FA + extra	He doesn't always work He isn't always working I am not usually happy
Question	verb + subject + FA + extra	Do you always smoke? Are you always smoking?
