Auxiliary Verb Subject Main Verb Adverb of Frequency

Are you smoking **three times a week?**

Rule	Structure	Example
Affirmative	subject + FA + verb	I always dance
Affirmative (long adverb)	FA + subject + verb subject + verb + FA	Three time a week, I dance I dance three times a week
Affirmative (to be)	subject + be + FA + extra	I am always dancing
Negative	subject + neg + FA + extra	He doesn't always work He isn't always working I am not usually happy
Question	verb + subject + FA + extra	Do you always smoke? Are you always smoking?
