Look at the sentences below, then rewrite them to include a possessive pronoun.

*This is my phone. That is **his phone** → This is my phone and that is hers.*

- 2) These are my shoes. Those are **her shoes**.
These are my shoes and those are hers.
- 3) This is your pencil. That is **my pencil**.
This is your pencil and that is mine.
- 4) Here is my tennis ball. There is **your tennis ball**.
Here is my tennis ball and there is yours.
- 5) This is my pet. That is **their pet**.
This is my pet and that is theirs.
- 6) I am in my bedroom. You are in **your bedroom**.
I am in my bedroom and you are in yours.
- 7) This is my cushion. That is **our cushion**.
This is my cushion and that is ours.
- 8) Where is my car? Where is **your car**?
Where is my car? Where is yours?
- 9) This is my favourite pastry shop. That is **her favourite pastry shop**.
This is my favourite pastry shop and that is hers.
- 10) Here is my motorbike. There is **his motorbike**.
Here is my motorbike and there is his.
- 11) I like my dress. I don't like **her dress**.
I like my dress but I don't like hers.

- 12) My favourite food is watermelon. **His favourite food** is chocolate.
My favourite food is watermelon and his is chocolate.
- 13) I can feel my fingers. You can't feel **your fingers**.
I can feel my fingers but you can't feel yours.
- 14) This is my wardrobe. That is **my children's wardrobe**.
This is my wardrobe and that is theirs.
- 15) Here is my belt. There is **your belt**.
Here is my belt and there is yours.
