

## Sentence Structure

Sentences tend to follow a particular structure in English. Each part of speech is placed in a specific location.

- 1) Noun  $\rightarrow$  person, animal, place, thing, idea
- 2) Verb → action, feeling, process, state, happening
- 3) Subject → name, noun, noun phrase, pronoun
- 4) Adjective → describes a noun
- 5) Adverb  $\rightarrow$  time, manner or place to add information

The most common sentence structures are;

- Verb (known as the imperative form)
   Watch!
- 2) Subject + Intransitive Verb She runs
- Subject + Intransitive Verb + Adverb
  She runs quickly
- 4) Subject + Transitive Verb + Object She likes chocolate
- 5) Subject + Linking Verb + Noun/Adjective She is a teacher
