



## Sentence Structure

---

Sentences tend to follow a particular structure in English. Each part of speech is placed in a specific location.

- 1) Noun → person, animal, place, thing, idea
- 2) Verb → action, feeling, process, state, happening
- 3) Subject → name, noun, noun phrase, pronoun
- 4) Adjective → describes a noun
- 5) Adverb → time, manner or place to add information

---

The most common sentence structures are;

- 1) Verb (known as the imperative form)  
**Watch!**
- 2) Subject + Intransitive Verb  
**She runs**
- 3) Subject + Intransitive Verb + Adverb  
**She runs quickly**
- 4) Subject + Transitive Verb + Object  
**She likes chocolate**
- 5) Subject + Linking Verb + Noun/Adjective  
**She is a teacher**
