| Present Simple  | Present Continuous  |

| Personal Information  | Right now   |
| My name is Hannah   | I am teaching you   |
| Facts and Truths  | Processes   |
| The world is round  | I'm studying to become a teacher  |
| Habits  | Before and After  |
| I play tennis every Saturday  | At 7am, I'm normally having a shower  |
| *This event never changes   | *Flexibility in the time of the event *Flexibility in the routine *Often used with adverbs of frequency |
| Future Events She has English class tomorrow *Scheduled and timetabled event *Pre-planned and organised | Future Events My mum is visiting me on Saturday *Not scheduled event *Involve other people              |
| Stative Verbs   | Chocolate in State  |
| She wants chocolate   | The children are growing up so quickly  |
