Present simple and present continuous tenses are used to express something in the present time.

Present Simple	Present Continuous
Personal Information <i>My name is Hannah</i>	Right now <i>I am teaching you</i>
Facts and Truths <i>The world is round</i>	Processes <i>I'm studying to become a teacher</i>
Habits <i>I play tennis every Saturday</i> *This event never changes	Before and After <i>At 7am, I'm normally having a shower</i> *Flexibility in the time of the event *Flexibility in the routine *Often used with adverbs of frequency
Future Events <i>She has English class tomorrow</i> *Scheduled and timetabled event *Pre-planned and organised	Future Events <i>My mum is visiting me on Saturday</i> *Not scheduled event *Involve other people
Stative Verbs <i>She wants chocolate</i>	Chocolate in State <i>The children are growing up so quickly</i>
