



What Is The Superlative Form?

The superlative form is a special grammatical structure that is **applied to adjectives** in English.

If we want to **compare three or more nouns** using the same adjective, that's when we need the superlative form.

It is used to express that one object has
the highest scale of the adjective
compared to three or more nouns.

Before every superlative sentence in English **we must use the word THE.**
This is an essential part of the
superlative form.

For example

The elephant is the biggest animal.
