#### **EXERCISE A**

Fill in the table below to review the rules for adjectives that are one syllable.

Adjective	Rule
old	Add ER to the end of the adjective. Old $\rightarrow$ older
large	Add R to the end of the adjective when the final letter is E. large $\rightarrow$ larger
big	Double the final consonant when the last three letters are consonant, vowel, consonant. Big → bigger

#### **EXERCISE B**

Fill in the table below to review the rules for adjectives that are three syllables.

Adjective	Rule
comfortable	Add "more" before the adjective. Comfortable → more comfortable

## **EXERCISE C**

Fill in the table below to review the rules for adjectives that are two syllables.

Adjective	Rule	
clever	<ul> <li>Either add ER to the end of the adjective. Cleverer</li> <li>Or say "more" plus the adjective More clever</li> </ul>	
happy	Eliminate the Y and add IER when the final letter is Y. Happy $\rightarrow$ happier	
tired	When the final letters are ED, FUL, ING, LESS, IVE, OUS

What are the following irregular adjectives in the comparative form?

Adjective	Comparative
good	better
bad	worse
far	farther/further
many	more
little	less
