EXERCISE A

Fill in the table below to review the rules for adjectives that are one syllable.

Adjective	Rule
old	Add EST to the end of the adjective. Old \rightarrow oldest
large	Add ST to the end of the adjective when the final letter is E. large \rightarrow largest
big	Double the final consonant when the last three letters are consonant, vowel, consonant. Big \rightarrow biggest

EXERCISE B

Fill in the table below to review the rules for adjectives that are three syllables.

Adjective	Rule	
comfortable	Add "most" before the adjective. Comfortable → most comfortable	

EXERCISE C

Fill in the table below to review the rules for adjectives that are two syllables.

Adjective	Rule	
clever	 Either add EST to the end of the adjective. Cleverest Or say "most" plus the adjective Most clever 	
happy	Eliminate the Y and add IEST when the final letter is Y. Happy \rightarrow happiest	
tired	When the final letters are ED, FUL, ING, LESS, IVE, OUS use "most" plus the adjective.

What are the following irregular adjectives in the superlative form?

Adjective	Comparative
good	best
bad	worst
far	farthest/furthest
many	most
little	least
