



We can use lots of different adjectives to describe clothing in English, but these adjectives must go in a specific order.



The different types of adjectives that are most useful to describe clothing are: opinions, colours, patterns and materials.



They must be used in this order

Opinion | Colour | Pattern | Material

Just be aware that the adjective "plain" is normally used as an opinion adjective, not a pattern adjective.
