


#### **Common Mistakes**

# Using "the" before a possessive pronoun

This book is mine







My coat is blue. Your is green.





Mixing up possessive adjectives and possessive pronouns.

My coat is blue. Yours is green.







Possessive pronouns refer to a noun previously mentioned in the sentence.

Possessive adjectives are used before a noun that is being introduced to the sentence.





Those are his dogs and these are mines





## Making possessive pronouns plural

Those are his dogs and these are mine





## Possessive pronouns are always singular





Are these phones your's?





# Using apostrophes with possessive pronouns

Are these phones yours?







Apostrophes are only used with the "possessive S" structure, not with possessive pronouns





#### I was with my sister and Fred was with hers





## Mixing the gender of possessive pronouns

I was with my sister and Fred was with <u>his</u>
