Look at each sentence. They are all incorrect. Explain why the sentence is incorrect and write the correct sentence in the spaces provided.

1) Is that laptop your's?

EXPLANATION

Possessive pronouns don't have an apostrophe in them.

CORRECT SENTENCE

Is that laptop yours?

2) Our house has four bedrooms. Their has five.

EXPLANATION

In a sentence where you are repeating the same noun (house), you need the possessive pronoun (theirs).

CORRECT SENTENCE

Our house has four bedrooms.
Theirs has five.

3) Those cards are mines.

EXPLANATION

Possessive pronouns only exist in one singular form, even if we are referring to a plural noun.

CORRECT SENTENCE

Those cards are mine.



4) Is this phone the yours?

EXPLANATION

We don't use the word "the" before a possessive pronoun in English.

CORRECT SENTENCE

Is this phone yours?

5) His phone is black. Her is pink.

EXPLANATION

When we are referring to a repeated noun (phone), we need a possessive pronoun (hers).

CORRECT SENTENCE

His phone is black. Hers is pink.

6) Is this coat your?

EXPLANATION

When we are referring to a previously mentioned noun we need the possessive pronoun.

CORRECT SENTENCE

Is this coat yours?

7) Are these earrings your's?

EXPLANATION

Possessive pronouns don't have an apostrophe in English.

CORRECT SENTENCE

Are these earrings yours?
