



ED Pronunciation Interactive Worksheet

In order to complete this worksheet, you should watch the pronunciation video about the ED pronunciation in English. You should complete this worksheet at the same time as watching the video.

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EXERCISE A: Fill in the gaps with the correct number or letter/s.

There are **3** different ways to pronounce the letters ED when they are at the end of a word. These are **/t/**, **/d/** and **/ɪd/**.

EXERCISE B: Select the correct options to complete the sentences below.

- ☐ The sound /k/ is **a voiced** / **an unvoiced** sound.
- ☐ The sound /l/ is **a voiced** / **an unvoiced** sound.

EXERCISE C: Fill in the gaps with the correct letter/s.

If the penultimate sound in a verb, before the ED, is an unvoiced sound, then the pronunciation of the letters ED is **/t/**. These unvoiced sounds are: **/p/**, **/k/**, **/f/**, **/θ/**, **/ʃ/**, **/s/** and **/tʃ/**.

EXERCISE D: Fill in the gaps with the correct letter/s.

If the penultimate sound in a verb, before the ED, is a voiced sound, then the pronunciation of the letters ED is /d/. These voiced sounds are: /b/, /n/, /m/, /j/, /ŋ/, /r/, /v/, /w/, /l/, /ð/, /tʃ/, /ʒ/ and /z/.

EXERCISE E: Fill in the gaps with the correct letter/s.

If the penultimate sound is an exception sound, then the pronunciation of the letters ED is /ɪd/. These exception sounds are: /t/ and /d/.
