We've arrived at the supermarket and today we are going to **Sainsbury's**, which is one of the "big four" supermarkets in the UK. First we're going to queue outside the door and then I'm going to put my **pound coin** into the shopping trolley. So let's go and queue.

OK, we are inside the supermarket now. I've put my shopping bags out inside the shopping trolley so I can put all of my food inside. In this supermarket, there's a really great app that I can use where we open this and simply scan the **barcode** of the product, so let's take a look! So I want some raspberries and we scan the barcode and you can see the product appearing there. OK, that's on the list and now we put it in the shopping bag. I'm going to walk down every aisle in the supermarket to make sure I get all the products that I need.

OK, let's quickly review some vocabulary while it's quiet. This space here is an **aisle**. It's like a corridor and it's long and straight and you can find these in a church and also in a supermarket, on an aeroplane. That long corridor is an aisle. I also have **shopping bags**, these are reusable bags, so we're helping with the environment. And this is the **shopping trolley**, which is the big metal basket. This is on wheels but if there's one that you carry in your hands, this is a **shopping basket**.

OK, I have finished my supermarket shop and I'm going to pay at the **checkout**. We are going to use the **self-checkout** so I can scan the shopping list, everything I have bought as you will see down there and then we can pay and leave.

OK, now we are at the self-checkout so I click "pay now" and I can scan the barcode and you'll see everything I bought appears on the screen and all I need to do is pay. Now I have a **loyalty card**, which collects points every time I shop here. So now I'm going to pay and I insert my **debit card** into the **card machine**. So now I have completed my purchase and I get a little piece of paper at the end with everything that I have bought. This is called a **receipt** in English.

So I've completed my supermarket shop of the week. I have all my food in my shopping bag and I've collected my pound coin from the shopping trolley. Now it's time to go home and put all my food in the cupboards.
