

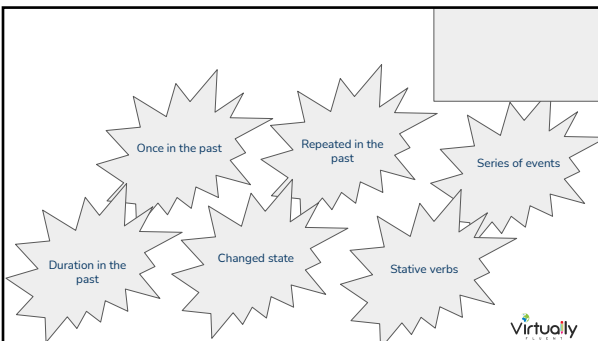

I drove to work every day

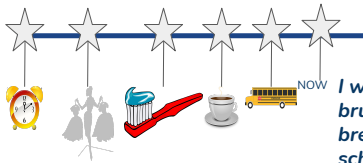
He walked to school every morning


