To care	keə	To feel interest and concern
To clean	kliːn	To remove dirt
To cuddle	<u>k</u> ʌdɪ	To hold in your arms and show love
To dig	dɪg	To go deep into earth and break into small pieces
To feed	fiːd	To give food
Food bowl	fuːd bəʊl	A place to put the food of animals
Hay	heɪ	A type of dried grass
Food pellets	fuːd <u>p</u> ɛlɪts	A small, round, solid material
To groom	grʊm	To brush and clean an animal's coat
To jump	dʒʌmp	To go into the air
To kiss	kɪs	To touch with the lips
To lick	lɪk	To touch with the tongue
Litter tray	<u>l</u> ɪtə treɪ	A place with absorbent material for animals to go to the toilet
To look after somebody	lʊk <u>a</u> ftə <u>s</u> ʌmbədi	(to care) To show interest, love and concern for somebody
To moult	mɒlt	The process of hair leaving an animal
Pen	pɛn	A fenced area to enclose something
Rabbit hutch	<u>r</u> æbɪt hʌtʃ	An outdoor house for a rabbit
To rinse off	rɪns ɒf	To quickly wash with water (no soap)
To run around	rʌn ə <u>r</u> aʊnd	To run and do a lot of exercise
