



There are many different expressions we can use to say you are going on holiday. Let's take a look at the most common ones!



TO GO ON HOLIDAY

This is mostly used by British English speakers.

I'm going on holiday next week!





TO GO ON VACATION

This is mostly used by American English speakers.

I'm going on vacation next week!





TO VISIT SOMEWHERE

This is a verb, so it can be used in any tense.

I'm visiting my grandma's house on Saturday.





TO GO ON A TRIP

You can also use the expression "to take a trip".

We're going on a trip to London!





TO TRAVEL SOMEWHERE

This means to go to a new place that is normally far away. This is a <u>verb</u>.

We're travelling to Antigua next month.



A JOURNEY

This talks about the movement from one place to another. It is used as a **noun**.

The car journey was 4 hours!
