Adjective Order

In English, adjectives always go before the noun unless there is a linking verb. But they must be written in a specific order.

QUANTITY

A number three, a dozen, four hundred

OPINION

A personal or general opinion nice, horrible, amazing

SIZE

Height, weight, length, width tall, small, light, big

PHYSICAL QUALITY

Feeling, look fat, rough, tidy, good-looking

AGE

old, young, thee-year-old, new

SHAPE

round, square, triangular

COLOUR

red, pale blue, yellow

ORIGIN

Nationality British, French, American

MATERIAL

wooden, metal, paper

What do you do with this?

PURPOSE writing, walking, cleaning

Examples: Three nice big juicy apples. An amazing new cleaning tool. The beautiful round British wooden table.
