Drinks Vocabulary

House wine > a wine that the pub/bar has bought in bulk so is normally available. This is generally good value for money.

On the rocks > with ice

With a twist > with a slice of fruit (normally lemon/lime)

Neat/straight > with no ice and no mixers - poured directly from the bottle into the glass
