\*Regular verbs add ED to form the past simple, but there are many irregular verbs too (this is the second column in the irregular verb table)

1

To talk about one individual event that happened in the past and finished in the past. **I went to Germany last summer.**



2

To talk about an event that happens repeatedly in the past at a regular interval. This does not happen now. **I walked to school every morning.**



3

A series of past events happening one after another. All events are finished now. **I woke up, got dressed and brushed my teeth.**



4

To talk about a duration of time in the past. This has finished now. **I lived in Barcelona for 3 years.**



5

To talk about something that has changed state from the past to the present (there are normally 2 parts). **She was short as a child, but now she's tall.**
