

# Travel Common Mistakes

Making mistakes with transport verbs is very common, so let's take a look at the top mistakes and how to avoid them yourself!

1

**I rode the bus here**

The verb "ride" means to be on top of something, so this means you were standing on the top of the bus! There are two options to correct this...

CORRECT: **I took the bus here**

CORRECT: **I rode on the bus here**

2

**I took the car to work today**

"To take" transport means you are not in control of the vehicle, so if you are driving, this sentence is incorrect.

CORRECT: **I drove the car to work today**

3

**I got in the tube**

The verb "to get in" transport is only used for small vehicles like cars and taxis. Otherwise we need "to get on".

CORRECT: **I got on the tube**
