## **Travel Common Mistakes**

Making mistakes with transport verbs is very common, so let's take a look at the top mistakes and how to avoid them yourself!



## I rode the bus here

The verb "ride" means to be on top of something, so this means you were standing on the top of the bus! There are two options to correct this...

**CORRECT: I took the bus here** 

**CORRECT: I rode on the bus here** 



## I took the car to work today

"To take" transport means you are not in control of the vehicle, so if you are driving, this sentence is incorrect.

**CORRECT: I drove the car to work today** 



## I got in the tube

The verb "to get in" transport is only used for small vehicles like cars and taxis. Otherwise we need "to get on".

**CORRECT: I got on the tube**
