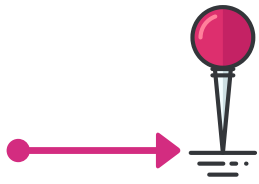
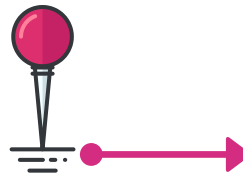

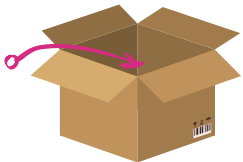

I put my phone in the box



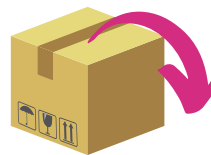
out (of)

I go up the stairs to the first floor



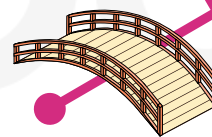
down

I go down the stairs to the basement



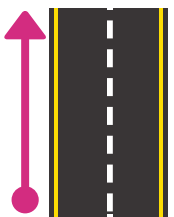
over

I walked along the road



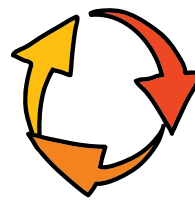
through
