When we measure distance, we have two types of measurements; **imperial** and **metric**.

foot (ft) (')


furlong (fur)

AREA



When we measure area, we also have two types of measurements; **imperial** and **metric**.

metres squared (m²) hectare (ha)

IMPERIAL

square feet (ft²) acre (ac)





SPEED



When we measure speed, we also have two types of measurements; **imperial** and **metric**.





METRIC



kilometres per second (km/s) kilometres per hour (km/h)



SPEED

miles per second (mps)
miles per hour (mph)





CAPACITY



When we measure capacity and volume, we also have two types of measurements; **imperial** and **metric**.

mililitre (ml) litre (l)

centilitre (cl) cubic metres (m³)

fluid ounce (fl oz) quart (qt)

gill (gi) gallon (gal)

pint (pt)

When we measure weight, we also have two types of measurements; **imperial** and **metric**.

grams (g) metric tonne (t)
