Adverb of Manner	Phonetic Transcription	Example Sentence
accidentally	ækʃɪdɛntəli	<i>I dropped my phone on the floor accidentally</i>
anxiously	æŋkʃəsli	<i>We waited for the results anxiously</i>
badly	bædli	<i>He plays the guitar very badly</i>
beautifully	bju:təfʊli	<i>She sings so beautifully</i>
bravely	breɪvli	<i>They fought for their country bravely</i>
brightly	braɪtli	<i>The sun shone brightly</i>
calmly	kɑ:mli	<i>She walked around the room calmly</i>
carefully	keəfli	<i>We opened the box carefully</i>
cheerfully	tʃiəfʊli	<i>She danced around cheerfully</i>
closely	kləʊsli	<i>He walked closely by my side</i>
correctly	kə'rektli	<i>We answered the questions correctly!</i>
deliberately	dɪlɪbəɪtli	<i>I left the door open deliberately</i>
easily	i:zɪli	<i>He lifted the suitcase easily</i>
equally	i:kwəli	<i>We split the bill equally</i>
eventually	ɪvɛntʃəli	<i>She arrived at the party eventually!</i>
fast	fɑ:st	<i>We drove really fast</i>
generously	dʒenərəsli	<i>He gave me the keys generously</i>
gently	dʒɛntli	<i>Lift him up very gently!</i>

happily	<u>hæp</u> ɪli	We are happily married
hard	hɑ:d	I work really hard
healthily	<u>helθ</u> ɪli	I always eat healthily
honestly	<u>ɒn</u> ɪstli	Please answer me honestly
innocently	<u>ɪn</u> əsəntli	The dog looked at me innocently
kindly	<u>kaɪnd</u> li	She kindly helped me with my bags
lazily	<u>leɪz</u> ɪli	We sat in front of the TV lazily
loudly	<u>laʊd</u> li	Stop playing the music so loudly!
mysteriously	mɪst <u>ɪər</u> iəsli	He looked at me very mysteriously
neatly	<u>ni:t</u> li	She neatly folded the laundry
nervously	<u>nɜːv</u> əsli	He shook nervously
obediently	ə <u>bɪ</u> :diəntli	My children go to bed obediently
patiently	<u>peɪ</u> ʃəntli	We waited in the office patiently
politely	pə <u>ləɪt</u> li	She asked me ever so politely

quickly	<u>kwɪk</u> li	You ran away very quickly!

sadly	<u>sæd</u> li	The cat looked at me so sadly

sensibly	<u>sɛn</u> səbli	<i>She sensibly went home early</i>
seriously	<u>sɪə</u> rɪəsli	<i>I can't take her seriously</i>
silently	<u>səɪ</u> ləntli	<i>They walked into the exam hall silently</i>
slowly	<u>sləʊ</u> li	<i>We slowly came to a stop</i>
softly	<u>sɒf</u> tli	<i>She stroked the dog softly</i>
stupidly	<u>stjuː</u> pɪdli	<i>He stupidly said yes!</i>
successfully	sək <u>sɛs</u> fʊli	<i>I successfully passed the exam</i>
suspiciously	səs <u>pɪ</u> ʃəsli	<i>Why is he acting so suspiciously?</i>
truthfully	<u>truːθ</u> fʊli	<i>Give your statement truthfully</i>
violently	<u>vaɪ</u> ələntli	<i>He violently hit her</i>
well	wɛl	<i>She was doing so well</i>
