When we talk about playing a musical instrument to improve, we use the verb to practise.

American English speakers write *practice*, whilst British English speaker write *practise*.



The verb to practise follows the same structure as the verb to play.

Please don't mix up these verbs! We only use practise to say you are trying to improve, preparing for a class or an exam.
