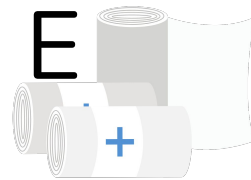
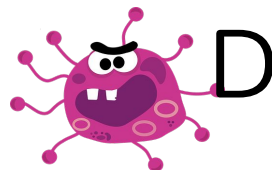
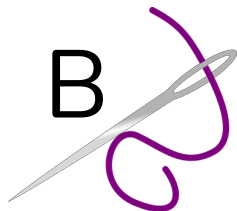
# At The Doctor's

## STORY A: Charlie

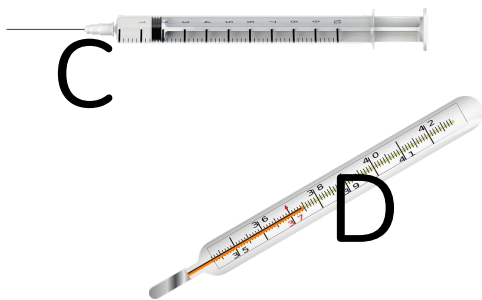

## STORY B: Julia

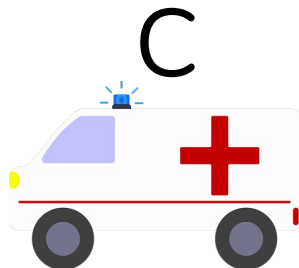
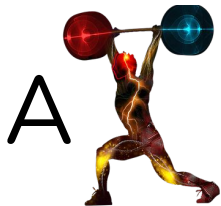

## STORY C: Richard

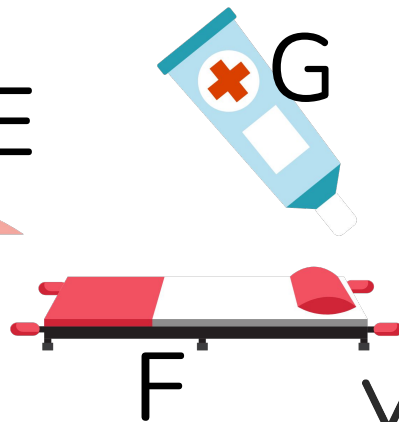
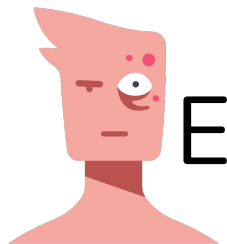
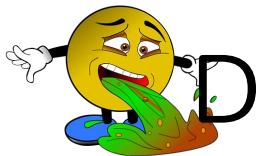
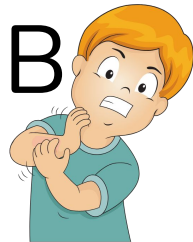
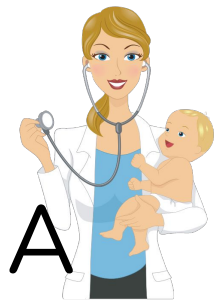

## STORY D: Michael

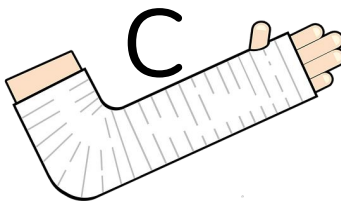
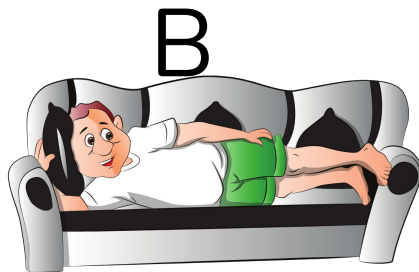
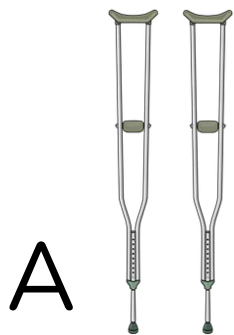

## STORY E: Lily

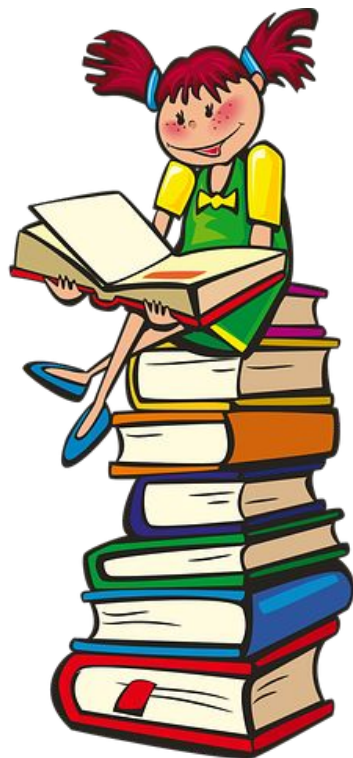
