Airport Check-In

Staff: Your departure gate is 4B. Boarding time will be 11.40 and your seat is 4C. Security is just over here.

You: Thank you!

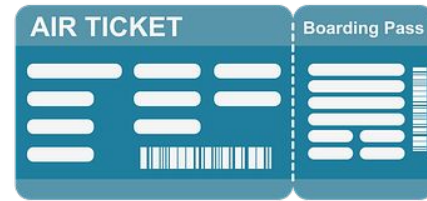

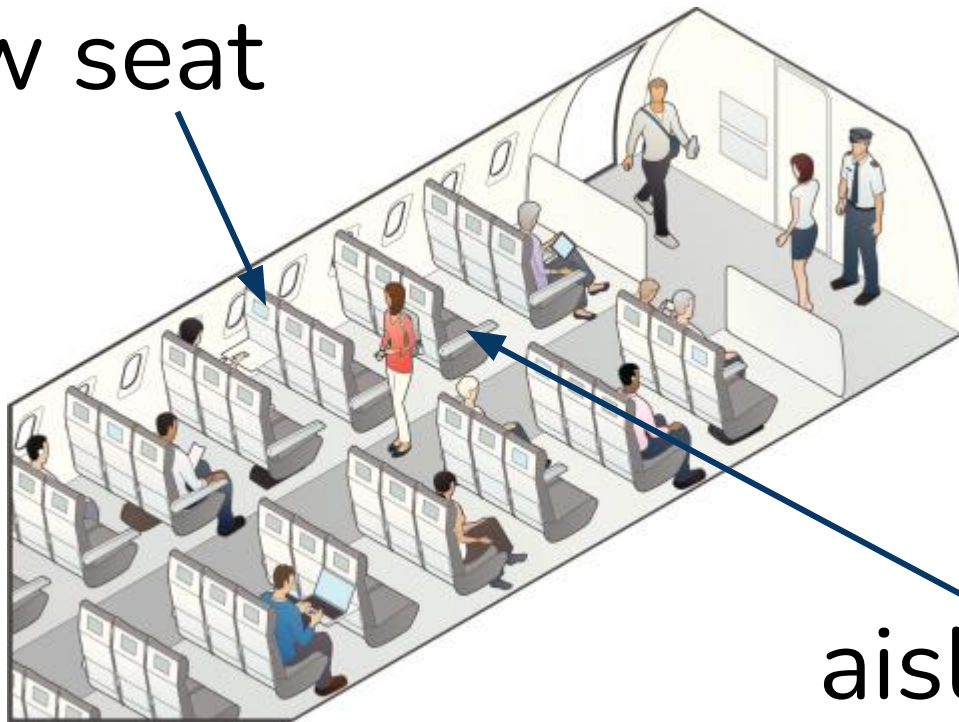
