

Present Continuous Common Mistakes

Let's take a look at the typical mistakes that English learners make in the present continuous tense.





I'm liking it

Many English learners use stative verbs in the present continuous tense. They cannot be used in this tense.





I like it







Where they waiting for you?

Many English learners forget to follow the question formation structure in this tense, don't forget your auxiliary verb!





Where are they waiting for you?





I dancing

English learners tend to forget to verb to be in the affirmative structure, especially with contractions.





I am dancing







You still are watching TV

English learners sometimes mix up the keywords and place them in the wrong position in the sentence.





You are still watching TV
