An ascent - to ascend (ascended)

To go up (went up - gone up)

An improvement - to improve (improved)

To soar (soared)

A decrease - to decrease (decreased)

A drop - to drop (dropped)

A plunge - to plunge (plunged) To worsen (worsened)

To remain constant To be unchanged
