Tennis




Tennis is a ball sport that can be played in **singles** (1 person v 1 person) or **doubles** (2 people v 2 people).

Equipment









Tennis is played on a **tennis court**. In the centre there is a **net**, over which the ball must be hit. There are various **white lines** around the court to show if the ball is out or in play.



Tennis is divided into individual **games**. Each game has points - 0, 15, 30 and 40. If two players are on 40, this is **deuce**. Then, you must win two consecutive points (**advantage** and another point) to win the game. A player must win 6 games to win a **set**. They must win 2 or 3 sets (depending on gender) to win the **match**. When players have equal games and sets, this is a **tiebreaker**. The winning point in the match is the **match point** and the winning point in each set is the **set point**.
