

## Used To, Usually, Use

All three words have entirely different functions and definitions in an English sentence.

Word	Pronunciation	Use/ Definition	Example Sentence
Used to	<u>ju:</u> zd tu:	A past habit that no longer happens (plus infinitive verb)	I <u>used to go</u> to school
Usually	<u>ju:</u> ʒชəli	Generally, a present habit	I <u>usually</u> do my homework at night
To use (verb)	tu: ju:z	To employ something Past tense: used	How do I use my laptop?
Use (noun)	juːs	Value/purpose	What's the use of being sad?



## LOOK OUT

 $\triangle$  "Used to" requires the infinitive "use to" (no D) in the negative and questions.
