

Past Perfect Keywords



There are lots of keywords that can be used in the past perfect tense. Let's take a look!





Before is used with the past simple past of the sentence.

The shop had closed **before** we arrived







The shop had closed **before** we arrived





After is the exact opposite and it used with the past perfect part of the phrase.

I got home <u>after</u> they had finished their homework







I got home <u>after</u> they had finished their homework





This must be used with a time phrase after.

2 years
For 3 months
5 days





For explains how long the first event happened.


I had been at university **for 4 years** when I left



When is used with the past simple part of the sentence.

Mary had left work when I arrived







Mary had left work when I arrived





By the time is also used with the past simple part of the sentence.

By the time I finished my degree, I had learnt a lot







By the time I finished my degree, I had learnt a lot
