



#### **Parent Tip**


Ask "what is this?" for any object and the response requires an indefinite article "It's a/an ..."

# But verbs ending in O are different for he/she:

l Positive	l Negative	He/ She Positive	He/She Negative
l do	l don't do	He does	He doesn't
homework	homework	homework	do
			homework

# Have is also different for he/she:

l Positive	l Negative	He/ She Positive	He/She Negative
I have	l don't	He has	He doesn't
lunch	have up	lunch	have lunch



#### **Parent Tip**

The present simple tense is used when talking about daily routine and regular habits. You can practise this tense by asking "what do you normally do each day?"






