- 1) I break my ankle. (seldom) → **I seldom break my ankle.**
- 2) She writes reports. (hardly ever) → **She hardly ever writes reports.**
- 3) I go to school. (never) → **I never go to school.**
- 4) I have visited London. (hardly) → **I have hardly visited London.**
- 5) We have gone to the shops. (at no time) → **We have at no time gone to the shops.**
- 6) They have lost the house keys (not once) → **They have not once lost the house keys.**
- 7) I watch TV. (no longer) → **I no longer watch TV.**
- 8) He is playing the trombone after giving up the piano. (no sooner) → **No sooner after giving up the piano is he playing the trombone.**
- 9) We are working. (barely) → **We are barely working.**
- 10) You can eat the pizza slices once you have finished your homework (only when) → **You can only eat the pizza slices when you have finished your homework.**
- 11) We want some English classes. (scarcely) → **We scarcely want any English classes.**
- 12) She will see us tomorrow. (under no circumstances) → **She will under no circumstances see us tomorrow.**
- 13) They are going to watch the match later. (in no way) → **They are in no way going to watch the match later.**
- 14) I have heard the best orchestra in the world. (never) → **I have never heard the best orchestra in the world.**
- 15) She knows of the surprise. (little) → **She knows little of the surprise.**
- 16) They told us about the pregnancy once we finished dinner. (only after) → **They only told us about the pregnancy after we finished dinner.**
- 17) They don't sell my favourite chocolate anywhere else. (nowhere) → **They sell my favourite chocolate nowhere else.**
- 18) She offered me a free ride home. (on no condition) → **She on no condition offered me a free ride home.**
- 19) I have heard him speak many times. (never) → **I have never heard him speak many times.**
- 20) She is very happy. (seldom) → **She is seldom very happy.**

## INVERTED SENTENCES

- 1) I seldom break my ankle. → **Seldom do I break my ankle.**
- 2) She hardly ever writes reports. → **Hardly ever does she write reports.**
- 3) I never go to school. → **Never do I go to school.**
- 4) I have hardly visited London. → **Hardly have I visited London.**
- 5) We have at no time gone to the shops. → **At no time have we gone to the shops.**
- 6) They have not once lost the house keys. → **Not once have they lost the house keys.**
- 7) I no longer watch TV. → **No longer do I watch TV.**
- 8) No sooner after giving up the piano is he playing the trombone.
- 9) We are barely working. → **Barely are we working.**
- 10) You can only eat the pizza slices when you have finished your homework.  
→ **Only when you have finished your homework can you eat the pizza slices.**
- 11) We scarcely want any English classes. → **Scarcely do we want any English classes.**
- 12) She will under no circumstances see us tomorrow. → **Under no circumstances will she see us tomorrow.**
- 13) They are in no way going to watch the match later. → **In no way are they going to watch the match later.**
- 14) I have never heard the best orchestra in the world. → **Never have I heard the best orchestra in the world.**
- 15) She knows little of the surprise. → **Little does she know of the surprise.**
- 16) They only told us about the pregnancy after we finished dinner. → **Only after we finished dinner did they tell us about the pregnancy.**
- 17) They sell my favourite chocolate nowhere else. → **Nowhere else do they sell my favourite chocolate.**
- 18) She on no condition offered me a free ride home. → **On no condition did she offer me a free ride home.**
- 19) I have never heard him speak many times. → **Never have I heard him speak so many times.**
- 20) She is seldom very happy. → **Seldom is she very happy.**
