We can also immediately AGREE



- I agree (with you entirely)
- You're absolutely right!
- I think so too
- That's a good point
- I don't think so either
- I feel the same way
- That's a very valid point!
- I think what you said is true



We can also immediately **DISAGREE**



- I (am afraid I have to) disagree
- I don't agree with you
- On the contrary
- I see your point, but ...
- With all due respect ...
- ➡ No offence, but ...
- Let's agree to disagree
- I don't share your opinion/view



We can also LIKE something



- Love/ adore
- Enjoy
- Have a soft spot for
- Fancy
- Be keen on
- Admire
- Have a thing for



We can also **DISLIKE** something



- Hate / detest / loathe
- Be not a (huge) fan of
- Be not my cup of tea
- Be not for me
- Be not my thing
