An act of kindness	ən ækt ðv	Something is done, similar to action.	<i>When a friend helped me cross the street, it was an act of kindness.</i>	
An assortment of cards, jewellery	ən əsɔːtmənt ðv	A large collection of different types of the same thing.	<i>I sell an assortment of burgers: hamburger, cheeseburger, chicken burger ...</i>

A bag of flour, sugar	ə bæɡ ðv	Numerous things together in a soft material container.	<i>I need to go to the supermarket and buy a bag of flour.</i>	
A bar of candy, chocolate	ə bɑːr ðv	A long block of something solid.	<i>Can I get a bar of chocolate at the shop?</i>	
A basket of apples, fruit, gifts	ə <u>bɑː</u> skɪt ðv	A container made of wood, which is in a particular “woven” pattern.	<i>She brought over a big basket of fresh fruit.</i>	
A bottle of juice, milk, water	ə <u>bɒt</u> l ðv	A glass or plastic container with a thin top, normally used to store liquids.	<i>Can I have a bottle of milk, please?</i>	
A bowl of cereal, rice, soup	ə bæʊl ðv	A deep dish used to store food.	<i>I'll have a bowl of rice, please.</i>	
A brand of biscuit, shampoo	ə brænd ðv	A collection of things made by the same company.	<i>What brand of shampoo do you use? L'Oréal.</i>

A carton of eggs, juice, milk	ə ka: tən ðv	A container made of thick cardboard.	<i>Can you pass me the carton of orange juice?</i>	
A centimetre of	ə sɛn tɪmi:tər ðv	(cm) A partitive measure for distance.	<i>My phone is 20cm long.</i>	
A cube of ice	ə kju:b ðv	A container with 6 surfaces, all exactly the same size.	<i>I don't want any cubes of ice in my drink.</i>	
A cup of coffee, tea	ə kʌp ðv	A container used to store liquids and can easily be drunk from.	<i>I've had 3 cups of tea today!</i>	
A day of	ə deɪ ðv	A partitive measure for time. The time when the sun is up and it is light.	<i>Today was a day of fun and games.</i>	
A game of cards, football, tennis	ə geɪm ðv	A partitive normally used with sports. A fun and interactive activity.	<i>Shall we have a game of tennis now?</i>

A glass of <i>juice, water, wine</i>	ə glɑːs ðv	A container made of a transparent material, normally used to store liquids.	<i>Would you like a glass of wine?</i>	
A gram of	ə græm ðv	(g) A partitive measure for weight.	<i>You need 10g of flour for this recipe.</i>	
A head of <i>hair</i>	ə hɛd ðv	The top part of the body, where the main features can be found.	<i>She is only a baby, but she has a full head of hair.</i>	
An hour of	ən aʊər ðv	(h) A partitive measure for time.	<i>I have an hour of English later this afternoon.</i>	
An item of <i>news</i>	ən <u>aɪ</u> təm ðv	One individual thing from a whole group of things.	<i>Have you read any interesting items of news recently?</i>	
A kilogram of	ə <u>kɪ</u> ləʊgræm ðv	(kg) A partitive measure for weight.	<i>This is 5kgs of potatoes.</i>

A kilometre of	ə <u>ki:l</u> əmi:tər ðv	(km) A partitive measure for distance.	<i>There is only 1km of road between your house and mine.</i>	
A kind of <i>biscuit, shampoo</i>	ə kaɪnd ðv	A group of things that have the same characteristics.	<i>What kind of biscuits do you like?</i>	
A litre of	ə <u>li:</u> tər ðv	(l) A partitive measure for volume.	<i>Can you fit a litre of water in that jug?</i>	
A metre of	ə <u>mi:</u> tər ðv	(m) A partitive measure for distance.	<i>This is a metre of cloth.</i>	
A minute of	ə <u>mi:</u> nɪt ðv	(m) A partitive measure for time.	<i>Could I borrow a minute of your day?</i>	
A month of	ə mʌnθ ðv	A partitive measure for time. A month is 28, 30 or 31 days long.	<i>December was a month of exams for me.</i>

A night of fun, sleep	ə naɪt ðv	A partitive measure for time. The time when the sun is down and it is dark.	<i>I had a really good night of sleep last night.</i>	
A packet of biscuits, sweets	ə pæk ɪt ðv	A plastic container with a group of the same object inside.	<i>Do you want a packet of sweets?</i>	
A pair of boots, glasses, jeans	ə peər ðv	Two things normally used together.	<i>I've lost my pair of blue jeans. Do you know where they are?</i>	
A piece of Information, paper, toast	ə pi:s ðv	One individual part of an entire thing.	<i>Could you pass me a piece of paper?</i>	
A plate of pasta, seafood	ə pleɪt ðv	A round, flat dish used for food.	<i>There was a big plate of pasta on the table.</i>	
A portion of food, salad	ə pɔ: ʃən ðv	One individual part of an entire thing.	<i>I only want a small portion of salad, please.</i>

A roll of paper	ə rəʊl ðv	Something that is kept in the shape of a tube.	<i>Could you pass me that roll of kitchen paper?</i>	
A second of	ə sɛk ənd ðv	(s) A partitive measure for time.	<i>I wasn't looking for a second of my time, then something happened!</i>	
A selection of shoes, pencils	ə sɪ lɛk ʃən ðv	A large group of different, but similar objects.	<i>I have a big selection of pencils.</i>	
A sense of humour, shame	ə sɛns ðv	An ability to understand.	<i>My sister has a very good sense of humour.</i>	
A set of tools	ə sɛt ðv	A collection of objects that all have the same purpose or are exactly the same.	<i>I have a set of tools in my garage.</i>	
A sheet of paper	ə ʃi:t ðv	An individual, thin layer of something, normally paper.	<i>I need a new sheet of paper to write on.</i>	
A shower of rain	ə ʃaʊ ə ðv	Light rain falling for a short period of time.	<i>We only had a few showers of rain yesterday.</i>

A sign of respect	ə saɪn ðv	An indication. Something to show a quality or event.	<i>Bowing in Japan is a sign of respect.</i>	
A slice of meat	ə slaɪs ðv	A thin, flat piece of a larger thing.	<i>Could you cut me a slice of meat, please?</i>	
A species of bird, mammal	ə <u>spi:</u> ʃi:z ðv	Living things that live together in certain groups and can mate with each other.	<i>Can you name a species of bird?</i>	
A sort of phone, laptop	ə sɔ:t ðv	A group of things that have the same characteristics.	<i>What sort of computer do you have at work?</i>	
A type of learning, technology	ə taɪp ðv	A group of things that have the same characteristics.	<i>I use lots of different types of technology in my lessons.</i>	
A variety of meat, desserts	ə vər <u>aɪ</u> əti ðv	A large group of things that have similar characteristics.	<i>I'll put a variety of desserts on the table. Help yourself!</i>

A vase of flowers	ə vɑːz ðv	A tall piece of glass or pottery. This is normally used to hold flowers.	<i>I love that vase of flowers in your window.</i>	
A week of	ə wi:k ðv	A partitive measure for time. 7 days.	<i>It's been a week of fun at my grandmother's house.</i>	
A year of	ə jɪər ðv	A partitive measure for time. 365 days.	<i>I've had an intensive year of studying English, but I think it was successful!</i>
