

Advanced Verb Formation

Verb formation is necessary when we have more than one main verb in the sentence. Some verbs use two forms but the meaning changes.

Infinitive	To + infinitive	Gerund
Forget	Didn't complete the activity I forgot to write that report	Completed the activity but don't have memory of it I forgot writing that report
Go on	Changes in the future to something different She went on to be CEO	Continues same activity in the future as now She went on being CEO
Quit	Stopped another activity in order to do this He quit to work here	Stopped this activity He quit working here
Regret	About to tell you the bad news I regret to tell you that you failed	Already told you the bad news but feel guilty about it I regret telling you that you failed
Remember	Checklist of activities to complete I remembered to visit my mum	A happy memory of a past event I remembered visiting my mum
Try	Difficult to do but you attempt it She tried to close the door	List of potential solutions to fix a problem She tried closing the door
Stop	Stopped another activity in order to do this I stopped to eat lunch at 12pm	Stopped this activity I stopped eating lunch at 12pm

- △ Need and mean are also used differently with these verb forms
- △ Some verbs don't change their meaning with two or more verb forms
